Location:	Moor Park School Moor Park, Richards Castle, Ludlow, Shropshire SY8 4DZ (school entrance GPS: 52.3437, -2.7335)

Entry Fee:	Senior – £6.00, Junior – £4.00, Disabled Archer – £1.50 <i>(Late entries – add £1 per archer if submitted after closing date.)</i> <i>On-line entries are now preferred but postal entries will be accepted. Payment by PayPal or Bank Transfer preferred. Cheques only with a minimum value of £20. Please refer to the Heritage page on the website.</i>	
Closing Date:	Wednesday 17 th July	
Rounds to be shot:	National rounds to Archery GB rules. Six sighters followed by four dozen arrows at longest distance and two dozen arrows at the next distance down, as detailed below. Archers will shoot 6 consecutive arrows at a time (each end).

Medals to be awarded:	1-3 entrants: Gold only 4-6 entrants: Gold and Silver only 7 or more entrants: Gold, Silver and Bronze	
Novice Medals to be awarded:	As above for two categories – Seniors and Juniors (See notes below)

Notes for Seniors	<p>As agreed by the county committee, Senior archers meeting the criteria below at the start of the season must shoot the Long National or New National:</p> <p>Lady recurve archer with a handicap of 50 = 436 National Gent recurve archer with a handicap of 44 = 500 National Lady compound archer with a handicap of 42 = 518 National Gent compound archer with a handicap of 37 = 555 National</p>
Notes for Juniors	<p>The ages of Juniors must be specified on the enclosed form. This ensures all Juniors shoot at least the minimum round for their age and gender group for the medal awards.</p> <p>Juniors wishing to shoot in the senior rounds will pay the senior fee to do so, and will be competing against the Seniors for medals.</p> <p>Juniors wishing to shoot a higher round than their own (within the junior rounds) will still pay the junior fee, but will compete against the age group they are shooting in for medals.</p>
Notes for Novices	<p>A Novice is an Archer who started shooting on or after 1st April 2018. In order to qualify for the novice awards, the archer must shoot the full distance appropriate to their age group and cannot have entered last year's competition as a Novice.</p> <p>There is one Senior category and one Junior category. The medal winners are Senior and Junior top scorers, irrespective of gender and bow type.</p>
Dress Code:	<p>This will be in accordance with the Archery GB Dress code. (Archery GB rule 307)</p>
Photography:	<p>In view of the provisions laid down in the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs at this event must register with the organiser before the start of the competition at the check-in tent on arrival.</p>

Directions:

From the **north** take the A49 Ludlow bypass. At the second roundabout ('Co-op Shop & Fuel'), continue on the A49 for two miles. Turn right on to the B4361 towards Ludlow.

From the **south** take the A49 for 1.8 miles north from the Woofferton crossroads (A456/B4362). Turn left on to the B4361 towards Ludlow.

Travel 0.8 miles north towards Ludlow on the B4361 and take the first left turn (very sharp!) towards Richards Castle. Moor Park School entrance is on the left after 0.7 miles.
